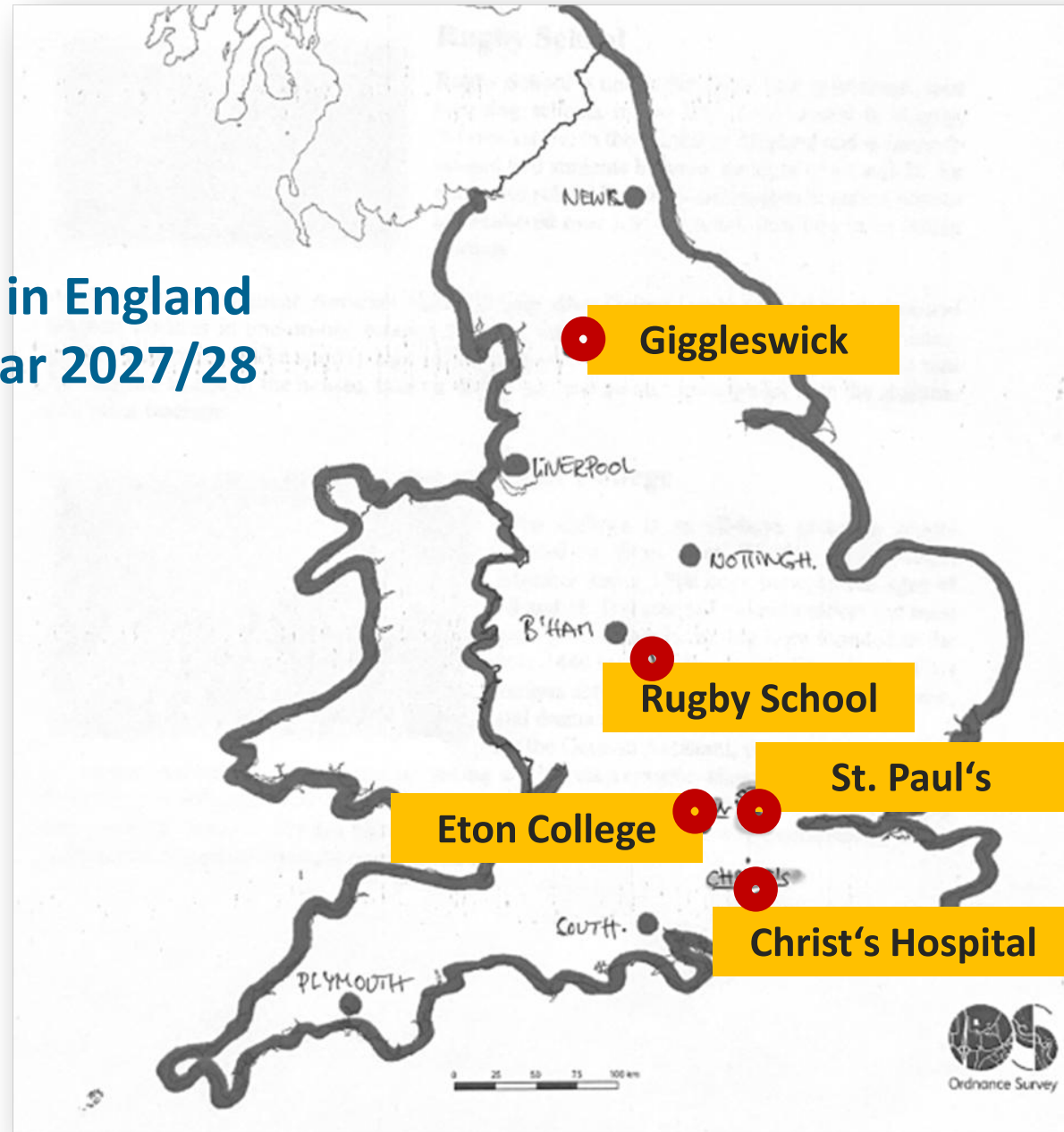

- # You are “**Bildungsinländer**” i.e. visited a German secondary school, obtained “**Hochschulreife**” and are a **student of / at GUF**
- # You are studying **English to become a teacher (any Lehramt)**
- # You always wanted to gain experience abroad?
- # You will be in your **4th or higher semester when starting** the assistantship
- # You believe it’s a good idea to find out what it is like to teach your dominant language as a foreign language by using your TEFL knowledge?

CHRIST'S HOSPITAL SCHOOL

- **“A school like no other”** halfway between London and Brighton in Horsham
- A **co-educational boarding** school situated near the picturesque market town of Horsham
- The school was founded by King Edward VI in 1552 to **help poor children in London** and offer them a safe place to live and to be educated. The school has stayed true to its founding principle and offers a wide range of scholarship and bursary programmes.
- This fact contributes to the enormous variety of pupils’ backgrounds, religious beliefs and ethnicities. Nowadays, more than 840 pupils **aged between 11 and 18 from all over the world** are living together on the grounds and make this school such a special place.
- As the Language Assistant, you will be **living on site with the pupils** and the majority of teachers.
- You will be responsible for individual conversation sessions with the older pupils and also be encouraged to do classroom teaching.

ST. PAUL'S SCHOOL LONDON

- Is one of the top private schools in the UK
- founded in 1509 and located right next to the Thames, in lively South-West London.
- The school's 950 boys are between the ages of 13 to 18.
- As the assistant, you will get free meals and a salary.
- **No accommodation on campus**, but your salary will be high enough to find yourself a room in a students' flat. The school / former TAs can support you with the room hunt.
- Your job will be to hold conversation classes with either individual students or in small groups.
- You will have **your own small office** where the students can come and see you for the lesson

ETON COLLEGE WINDSOR

- Eton College is looking for a German language assistant **for one year!**
- The school is an **all-boys boarding school** located in Eton, near Windsor.
- The school educates about 1300 boys between the **ages of 13 and 18**.
- It is one of England's oldest and most prestigious schools, many Royals and former Prime Ministers were educated at Eton (e.g. William, Harry, Boris Johnson)
- As the German Assistant, your main task will be to **prepare students for their exams** by having **weekly conversation classes** in German.
- Apart from that you will also have to **cover lessons** in the Languages Department and **attend the daily staff meeting**.
- You can always take on more responsibilities, which is not compulsory but is certainly an advantage for your personal career.
- Eton is definitely **a chance in a lifetime!**

RUGBY SCHOOL

- Rugby School is one of the oldest and most prestigious boarding schools in the UK.
- Located in Rugby, Warwickshire, in the middle of England, close to Birmingham, an hour's train ride from London
- The game **Rugby was invented here!**
- Home to around 950 students between the ages of 11 and 18. Its numerous school buildings and **sixteen boarding houses** are scattered **over half the town**, resulting in an ample campus.
- As the German Language Assistant, you will **help other German teachers** in their classes
- support students in **one-on-one tutoring** lessons.
- You will be **assigned to one of the houses**, take on duties, eat, and go on trips together with the students and other teachers
- You will also have time to engage in many extra-curricular activities (like sports), take part in excursions, and travel around England.

RUGBY SCHOOL

- You will teach **only six months** (Oct-March i.e. back for the summer semester)
- You will live in a in a boarding house!
- You can eat in school!
- You can use school facilities!
- You can try out teaching methods yourself & learn from different teachers in different subjects
- You are even paid a monthly salary for working there!

GIGGLESWICK SCHOOL

- *Giggleswick School* is located in a small village in **North Yorkshire**, an area with impressive hills and pastures.
- The school is mainly a castle and was founded in 1499 – making it one of England's oldest schools. Both Leeds & Manchester are only an hour away by car/train.
- It is a fairly small, **co-educational day & boarding school** with around **400 students**. Since *Giggleswick* has its own Junior School, assistants could have the opportunity to teach **learners at primary level**, too. The school offers a very broad extra-curricular programme with many exciting activities!
- You can also make **use of all the facilities** in school which include various sport courts, a gym, an internet café, and IT suites. You are also able to **join different teachers** during your stay.

GIGGLESWICK SCHOOL

What the school offers:

- You can limit the stay to six months; but 10 months is possible too.
- You can live in a lovely spacy shared flat – *for free!*
- You can eat in school – three times a day – *for free!*
- You can use all school facilities (like a gym) *for – free!*
- You can take part in all extra curricular activities, trips, excursions – for free!
- You can try out teaching methods yourself & learn from different teachers
- You will receive a sum of money at the end of your stay for your work and enough time to look for odd jobs in town (e.g. Nachhilfe)
- You have less work and more time / flexibility than other TAs

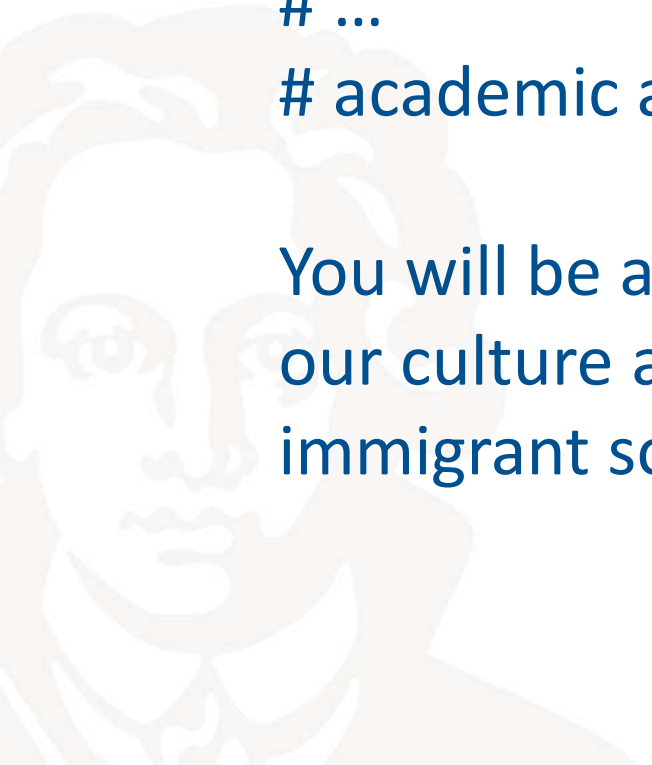
